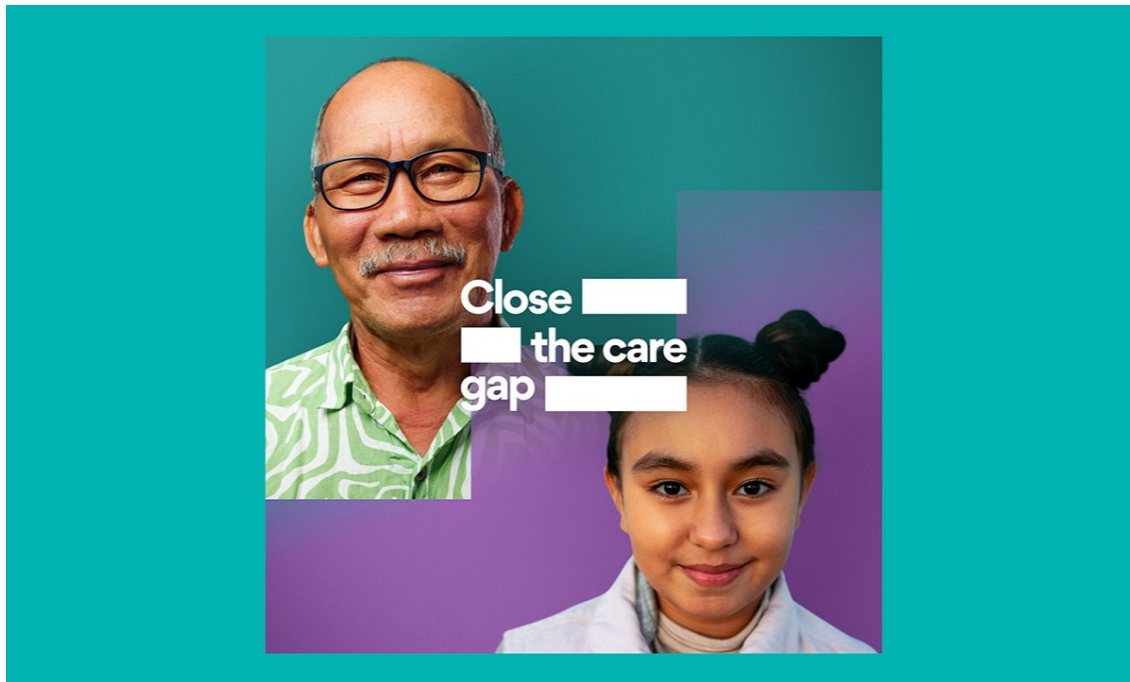
Public consultation in IDERHA
